What we do

We provide a range of information about the Association's activities through our website www.afpe.org.uk. The website has a secure log-in area that provides resources and information exclusive to members. Additionally we:

- Provide a range of accredited bespoke and National CPD activities through the **National College for Continuing Professional Development** including resources, regional CPD, coaching and mentoring support and occasional papers;
- Organise **regular meetings** through the regional and home country network in order to discuss regional and national priorities;
- Provide **insurance cover** for members, with optional additional cover available;
- Offer **advice and support** to individual members on a wide range of issues including health & safety, legal matters, curriculum issues and career advice;
- Offer **service level agreements** to provide physical education support to institutions & LAs;
- Provide opportunities for **consultancy work** for members;

- Publish **Physical Education Matters** and **Primary Physical Education Matters**, afPE's quarterly journals for members, which provide a forum for sharing professional views and opinions and feature articles on pedagogy, current issues and CPD;
