

### **Hotlink: Local Delivery Agency**

*A local delivery agency has developed an extensive local infrastructure, through which it is able to consult with stakeholders at each level. Key stakeholders include:*

- *Sports Colleges,*
- *School Sport Partnerships,*
- *Active Recreation Service*
- *Healthy Schools Team*
- *Institutes of further and higher education*
- *Sports Coach UK*
- *A range of national governing bodies of sport.*

*The CPD Development Group comprises:*

- *School Improvement Advisor,*
- *LEA Officers,*
- *Head Teachers*
- *and staff development managers in schools.*

*Regular formal and informal meetings at school level are backed up with annual needs analyses through the physical education networks, including the sports colleges and school sport partnerships. An analysis of evaluations from previous CPD is used to inform future provision.*

*In house expertise is used in the design and development of provision, involving school improvement advisors and advanced skills teachers.*

### **Hot link: Local Education Authority**

*In one LEA a School Effectiveness Service day is held in November each year, when schools INSET needs and opportunities are identified in conjunction with the EDP and the annual report. Individual subject specialists present a progress report relating to the EDP priorities. Analysis of CPD provided during the previous year is also taken into consideration. The service also references publications such as 'Good Value CPD – A Code of Practice for Providers of Professional Development Teachers – March 2001'.*

*The INSET advisory committee (includes primary and secondary head teachers, PDM, Advisors and Tutors in the national PESSCL programme) is also involved in this day and plays a valuable role in ensuring that development activities respond to the needs of schools, individuals and pupils. This links positively into recruitment.*
