## **Multi-skill provision**

At the LDA Strategic Seminars, there was some confusion raised regarding the available provision of the various Multi-skill and FUNdamentals training. The opportunities originating from consortium partners are:

*Primary FUNdamentals Module (PD/T)* is available to LDAs via the CPD Intranet. This module complements and underpins the delivery of FUNdamentals in the curriculum.

*An Introduction to the FUNdamentals of movement 3hours (MS2)* this practical workshop explores the concepts of Agility, Balance, Co-ordination and speed. It compliments other coach education resources which may focus on the movement skills of running, hopping, skipping etc.

*Multi Skill Club Induction Training. (MSi)* 6hour workshop Consists of x2 3hour sessions. A 3hour session Introducing the FUNdamentals of movement (MS2) followed by a x3 hrs Multi-skill Clubs in practice (MS3). This practical workshop is designed to help participants integrate the Agility, Balance Coordination into Multi-skill Club sessions.

Only available to CSPs supporting SSPs involved in Multi-Skills Clubs programme.

Other complementary workshops available:

*An Introduction to Long Term Athlete Development.* This theory workshop is aimed at coaches and teachers to enable them to understand the key concepts of LTAD and what it means to them and their practice.
